

## **Husson University Assistant or Associate Professor of Counselor Education** **Anticipated Opening**

### Job Summary:

This is an anticipated, full time position for an Assistant or Associate Professor in the Counseling and Human Relations graduate program located on our main campus in Bangor, Maine. Responsibilities include teaching graduate courses in our CACREP accredited master's degree programs (Clinical Mental Health Counseling and School Counseling). Core courses also include students in our Human Relations program. The successful candidate will serve a nine-month renewable contract, eligible for multi-year contract. Primary responsibilities include teaching a graduate load (9 credits per semester) with options to teach during summer sessions as well. The successful candidate may supervise practicum students and provide internship seminar as part of the teaching load. Responsibilities also includes advising students in the programs and engaging in service and scholarship activities. Individuals should demonstrate the ability to work collaboratively with a small, close-knit team of faculty, and possess a commitment to diversity and social justice and an interest in preparing counselors and human relations professionals for rural and small town service. Individuals from underrepresented groups are strongly encouraged to apply.

Husson University is a small, private, non-profit vibrant University located in beautiful Bangor, Maine. Bangor is thriving city with a major international airport, located in the center of Maine, with easy access to the coast, mountains, lakes, and forests. The Counseling and Human Relations program consists of CACREP accredited graduate programs in Clinical Mental Health Counseling and School Counseling, as well as a graduate program in Human Relations. Currently there are three (3) full time faculty members, one half time clinical coordinator, and 3-4 adjuncts serving 75 students.

### Minimum Qualifications:

Earned doctorate in Counselor Education, preferably from a CACREP-accredited program, OR a doctorate in a closely related field and employed as a full-time faculty member in a counselor education program for a minimum of one academic year prior to July 1, 2013.

### Preferred Qualifications:

Evidence of excellence in teaching in counselor education.

Experience providing supervision.

Evidence of leadership.

Familiarity with accreditation standards (CACREP) and assessment practices.
