Saybrook University is seeking a faculty member for the M.A. in Psychology: Counseling Specialization program to join its College of College of Social Sciences.

The Saybrook MA Psychology: Counseling Specialization program is a campus-based program, located in Bellevue, WA, just outside of Seattle. The curriculum is centered on a systemic, relational, and experiential model of education that offers courses in a highly interactive extended weekend format. Under the direction of the director, the faculty for M.A. in Psychology: Counseling Specialization is primarily responsible for teaching face-to-face courses in a highly interactive extended weekend format at the Bellevue campus. Additional teaching opportunities may exist with our online/hybrid counseling program within the College of Social Sciences at Saybrook.

Position responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Successful applicants will teach courses, assist with the practicum and internship experience, work closely with students and colleagues, and assume an active role in our program, as we seek to restructure the program to align with the 2016 CACREP standards.

Position Requirements:

- Requirements include a doctoral degree in Counselor Education from a CACREP accredited program by date of appointment. Licensure as an LMHC in Washington is required within one year of date of appointment.

Position Qualifications:

- Professional identity as a Counselor Educator, affiliation with relevant counseling associations (ACA, ACES), and experience with CACREP accreditation strongly preferred. Graduate-level face-to-face teaching experience, working with online delivery systems and work with diverse populations are preferred.
