Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will be expected to teach in core areas of counseling, and oversee all aspects of the practicum experience including assisting students in securing practicum sites, developing relationships with new sites, providing direct supervision, and evaluation and education of site supervisors. Emphasis will be on the LPC and MFT tracks. The applicant should also be prepared to assist with the CACREP accreditation process, provide academic advising, and teach in core areas of counseling.

- Licensable in Missouri as a LPC or LMFT.
- Minimum 3 years clinical supervision experience.

- Demonstrated commitment to excellence in teaching at the master's degree level.
